Legacy Circle Update Another Successful Year!

As Temple Sholom completes its fiscal year, and after our sixth year in participating in the regional CYJL (Create Your Jewish Legacy program), we wanted to provide a quick update on our Legacy Circle membership and program.

In the six years since this program started:

- 1. During the last fiscal year, we added seven new Legacy Commitments.
- 2. We now have eighty legacy commitments, over 25% of our Temple Sholom community.
- 3. Temple Sholom has realized \$97,500 in Legacy commitments as bequests or outright donations to our endowments.
- 4. Future estimated realizations of over \$1,600,000 are anticipated from its Legacy Circle members.
- 5. Temple Sholom has received over \$36,000 of unrestricted incentives grants because of the success of its Legacy Circle program and your participation!
